JOB DESCRIPTION

- Full Time Employee
- Will teach 2-3 activities
- Will rotate in and out of cabins and support every week
- Will have the opportunity to SC a bunkhouse
- Will assist the Cabin Counselor in the bunkhouse
- Will train extensively in Cabin and Support Counselor Job Responsibilities
- Will have a list of leadership responsibilities that you will be overseeing
 - Bathroom clean up
 - Nightly Clean up
 - General Areas of Responsibility
- Be prepared to take over the role of a Cabin Counselor and/or Support Counselor should Counselor become ill or get called away for an unforeseen event
- Will work alongside and lead JC's in various places
- Will help put on camp behind the scenes when needed
- Will be at JC check in on Mondays

ELIGIBILITY:

- Must have attended Brookhill
- Must have been a junior counselor
- Must agree to a background check
- Must be a high school graduate or older
- Must be able to complete the entirety of the time hired
- Must sign and comply with the Brookhill Ranch Code of Conduct
