

Junior Counselor Job Description

JOB DESCRIPTION:

- Part Time Employee
- Support Counselor Team or Cabin Counselor Team
 - Depending on what position you are applying for
- You will receive a paycheck after your first week of service

ELIGIBILITY:

- Must have attended Brookhill
- Must agree to a background check
- Must attend one of the JC Trainings offered prior to your hired session(s)
- Must have completed the 10th grade or higher
- Must be able to complete the entirety of the time hired
- Must be able to complete light to medium manual labor
- Must sign and comply with the Brookhill Ranch Code of Conduct
- Must complete a health evaluation 2 weeks prior to the session hired

BENEFITS:

- Leadership development
- Strengthened ability to complete required tasks with efficiency
- Enhanced ability to work with a team

EXPECTATIONS:

- Must conduct him or herself in a manner that is in accordance with the standards set forth by Brookhill Ranch
- Must be respectful of the other staff members, administration, campers, parents, and facilities
- Must be able to submit to and work for authority that is close in age
- The Junior Counselor will not be allowed to divulge any personal camper information, such as name, address, email or phone number, to any persons outside of Brookhill Ranch

DETAILED JOB DESCRIPTIONS

CABIN JC

- Serve in the bunkhouse and in activities
- Lead campers in having fun
- Responsible for helping clean facilities (bunkhouse, pavilion, EC, bathrooms, etc.)
- Taking out trash, sweeping, mopping, cleaning, etc.
- In 3 activities, helping the head counselor make the activity go smoothly and keeping campers safe
- To be a JC, you have to have a heart that is willing to serve
- Not a camper anymore, but employee/teammate



Junior Counselor Job Description

CAMPER RELATIONS JC

- Serve in the Care Package department
- Help receive, fill and deliver Care Package orders
- Make inventory runs and stock inventory
- Help with homesick campers
- Assist in putting on the the evening events of camp
- Will help with camper birthdays
- Will check on first time campers and gather information about their time at camp
- Will help with early departures and late arrivals
- Stay in the bunkhouse with the support staff team

ELIGIBILITY

- Must have organizational skills
- Must be a detailed person
- Must enjoy talking to people
- Must be a good communicator

CONCESSIONS

- Serve in the general store area
- Will possibly teach one or two activities
 - Help prep general store 2nd activity
 - Work in general store during lunch and other canteen times
- Help keep everything organized and stocked in general store
- Stay in the bunkhouse with the support staff team

FIRST AID JC

- Serve in the First Aid department
- Help with camper care and medicine
- Make activity rounds with members of the first aid team
- Stay in the bunkhouse with the support staff team

ELIGIBILITY

- Must not be made sick at the sight of blood
- Must have a strong immune system
- Must have patience

HORSEBACK JC

- Serve in the horseback barn
- Help feed, saddle, and bridle horses in the morning and after lunch
- Help the activity counselors with the horses that are having a difficult time
- Help care for the horses
- Stay in the bunkhouse with the support staff team

ELIGIBILITY

- Must have equine experience
- Must know how to bridle and saddle a horse



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HOUSE & GROUNDS JC

- Serve in the House & Grounds Team
- Will assist in the daily operations and facility maintenance of camp
- Will take care of minor "fix it" tasks
 - o Repair cabin screens
 - Fill Go Karts with gas before the activities
- Will be under the supervision of an all summer staff member who will help you with these tasks
- Stay in the bunkhouse with the support staff team

KITCHEN JC

- Serve in the kitchen to help prep meals, serve meals, and clean after meal
 - Wake up early to help prep, and use rest time to help prep
- 1st and 2nd activity are prep and rest time
- Help teach 3rd activity, helping the head counselor make the activity go smoothly and keeping campers safe
- Stay in the bunkhouse with the support staff team

MEDIA JC

- Serve in the media department
- Won't teach any activities but you will go to activities to help photograph and video them
- Stay in the bunkhouse with the support staff team

ELIGIBILITY

 Previous photography, social media and/or videography experience is needed (yearbook, experience editing film, etc.)

MERCH JC

- Serve in the Merch Hut
- Teach a first and second activity
 - o Help prep merch 3rd activity
 - o Work in Merch Hut during canteen times
- Help keep everything organized and stocked in Merch Hut
- Stay in the bunkhouse with the support staff team

OFFICE JC

- Serve in the camp office
- Assist the administration team in the daily responsibilities (ex. Answering phones, taking messages, preparing for upcoming camp sessions)
- Stay in the bunkhouse with the support staff team

ELIGIBILITY

- Must have legible handwriting
- Must be a second year JC or more
